The University Capsule provides a platform for young scholars to interact with the faculty of CAPS, and experience first-hand, the working of a security and strategic think tank.

In order for the program to proceed as per schedule, and for your convenience, we would like you to take note of the following points:

- The Capsule will be organised over a period of three days – 19 to 21 July 2017 (Wednesday-Friday), from 1030 hrs to 1600 hrs, in the Conference Room, located on the first floor of CAPS.
- However, the registration on the first day (July 19th) is at 1000 hrs
- A copy of the program and a document explaining how to reach Subroto Park has been mailed for your reference.
- Subroto Park is a high-security zone because it houses the headquarters of the Western Air Command, Indian Air Force. Hence, foreigners or students who are not Indian nationals would not be allowed to enter the premises.
- You would be asked to prove your identity while entering Subroto Park. Please carry a valid government issued photo identity card along with your college/university identity card for the same.
- The security check can be stringent depending on the circumstances. **You are advised to keep a buffer time of approximately 30 minutes for the security clearance process.** Please keep this in mind while planning the logistics.
- The **roads connecting to Subroto Park are prone to heavy traffic** and can get congested during peak hours. Please keep this in mind while planning your travel.
